Bird Bingo

Objective: to help students learn to recognize birds by sight and sound

Materials: Bird Bingo cards (it is helpful to laminate these), pencils or Vis-à-Vis markers.

Directions: Distribute the Bird Bingo cards to the students. Explain that you will be going outside to look and listen for birds that live in your local area. The students will get one free bird in the middle - the Carolina Wren. This is one of our most common birds in the Atlanta area. If you have a bird that is more common in your area you can change it. Feel free to adapt the bingo board for your area. As you hear and see the birds, have the students mark their boards. The first student to get an entire row horizontally, vertically or diagonally would call out "BIRDO."

Indoor Directions: You can still do this activity even if you can't go outside. First you will need to be familiar with the bird on the "Birdo" boards. Review pictures and sounds of the birds at <u>http://www.allaboutbirds.org/guide/search</u> After you have reviewed the birds with your students you can show pictures and play sounds of birds and the students can mark their boards.
